

In accordance with the North Whidbey Sportsmen's Association Bylaws, the Membership committee, as appointed by the President, has established the following process for new members:

1. The prospective member will attend a General Monthly Meeting. These are scheduled for the 2nd Wednesday of the month.
2. During that meeting, the prospective member will have the opportunity to introduce him or her self, and explain to the members why they seek membership in NWSA.
3. At the end of that meeting, the prospective member will submit the Membership application, and the Permission form for the background check, along with a \$25 fee (for the background check).
4. The membership committee will review the application at some time prior to the next General Meeting. They may request additional information from the applicant.
5. The President or his delegate will conduct the New Member Indoctrination class two hours prior to the next General Meeting. Attendance at this Indoctrination class is mandatory for all new members.
6. The new member will attend that General Meeting.
7. The new member will receive his Membership card in NWSA at the conclusion of that General Meeting (his second in the application/acceptance process).
