

“How to Become a Member”

Becoming a member of the North Whidbey Sportsmen’s Association generally takes about 30 days. These are the basic steps to membership:

1. Attend one of our monthly General Member’s Meetings in our clubhouse at 7:00 pm on the 2nd Wednesday of any month. You’ll be asked to introduce yourself and let the members present know why you want to join.
2. At the end of the meeting, submit a completed New Member Application as well as a Background Check Release Authorization (along with a \$26.50 fee). The Background Check and fee are only required one time as long as you don’t let your membership lapse.
3. Your membership package will be reviewed by our Membership Committee. You should receive their decision, or possibly a request for more information, within 2-3 weeks.
4. Approved applicants will be given the date of the next Indoc/Orientation class (normally held 2 hours prior to the monthly General Member’s Meeting on the 2nd Wednesday, but changed to the Saturday morning prior to the 2nd Wednesday during the winter due to lack of daylight!). **ATTENDANCE AT THE INDOC/ORIENTATION CLASS IS MANDATORY.** Final membership approval will not be given without proof of recent attendance.
5. Attend the next General Member’s Meeting where you will be sworn in and issued your membership card.
